





Performance Notes - History

Christmas Eve in My Home Town was written in 1951 during the Korean conflict. From the 1950's into the twenty-first century, it has been broadcast to troops overseas on the Armed Forces Network (AFN), and became known as "The Soldiers' Christmas Song."
